TIP DU JOUR: Site meant to help disabled find jobs

The New Jersey Business Leadership Network and the Henry H. Kessler Foundation recently launched www.AccessibleEmployment.org, a national job board dedicated to including disabled employees in the work force.

Similar to Monster.com or HotJobs, www.AccessibleEmployment.org was started to connect employers with disabled workers.

The site allows potential job candidates to post their resumes for review by prospective employers who have made a commitment to include people with disabilities in their work force.

People with disabilities represent the single largest minority group seeking employment in today's marketplace, organizers said. The unemployment rate of people with disabilities is 10 times greater than the national unemployment rate.
