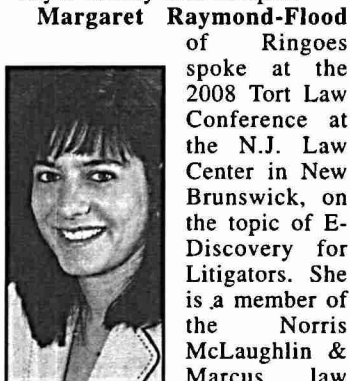


## Making News On The Job
